As a reminder to all residents, our snow removal contract is based on a snowfall of 3" or more.

Due to the size of our community, it may take the better part of a day and/or night before our contractors are able to plow and shovel each street, sidewalk and walkway.

We understand some of you need to leave your homes before anything has been cleared. However, we have no control of whose neighborhood gets cleaned first. Please be patient and use caution when you have to shovel and clean yourself.

During and after severe winter events, it is not possible to keep our entire community free of snow and ice at all times. Ice and snow treatments on walks, steps, and streets are repeated as conditions warrant, but proper care, concern and caution by everyone is still the best defense. Primary responsibility for personal safety resides with the individual.

Maintenance Items

Please report the following issues to Century 21 so that Maintenance repairs can be scheduled.

- Siding loose, damaged, or missing.
- Cracked, uneven sidewalks.
- Downspouts damaged or missing.



Trash & Recycling

- Please be sure to secure your trash & recycling – especially on windy days
- Trash should not be put out until 6:00 pm

SPECIAL NOTICE – Parking Issues

- > Parking at the corner of Lisa Lane & Greenspring is not allowed.
- > Parking on Lisa Lane to wait for School Bus is not allowed.
- > All cars need to park along Greenspring and be parked a minimum of a car length past the stop sign.
- > Those parking around the stop sign are impeding other drivers from safely entering or leaving the Crown Pointe Development.
